

# Dam of Belver - Pêgo Canoeing - Tejo River II





## Description

Starting downstream of the Belver Dam and ending at the Pego weir, it is a pleasant descent in a wide river for about 12km, with current, sometimes strong, resulting from the (controlled) discharge of that Dam. It has several rapids, the most exciting being the first in Belver and the last at the Pego weir. If the discharge does not happen, the descent may be reduced in length, depending on the physical condition of the group. The descent is accompanied by monitors with experience and training in canoeing. Halfway down there is a stop on the riverbank where participants can get food that they should bring from home.

**Duration:** 4 hours.

Meeting Point: 9:30am at Ortiga Fluvial Beach.

Minimum number of participants: 15. Offer 1 gratuity for each group of 25 payers.

# Logistics

After the meeting, the participants stay at the start of the descent. Before starting the descent, we will use our support car to place the participants' cars with drivers at the end of the descent. This way, when they finish the descent, they will have their cars at the end of the descent.



For the registration to be complete must be provided the name and phone number of the person leading the group. Also, a payment of 50% is required up to 5 days in advance using IBAN: PT50004534534027764108953 (proof of payment must be sent to geral@transserrano.com). A list with the complete names and birthdates, of all participants, must be sent by e-mail up to 2 days in advance (geral@transserrano.com).

## What you should bring

**SUMMER:** hat and sun block suitable for your skin, light clothing (shorts and t-shirt) or suitable for the weather conditions of the day, canteen or water bottle, light lunch (sandwiches, fruit, energy bars), closed sandals or old sneakers that can get wet (flip flops are not recommended), dry clothes for the finish and towel.

WINTER: warm and light clothing to wear underneath the neoprene suit, for example a sweater and thermal pants. If you don't rent or don't have neoprene boots, we recommend old sneakers, canteen or water bottle, light lunch (sandwiches, fruit, energy bars), dry and warm clothes for the finish and towel

### Recommendations

During the winter or in times of heavy rainfall, the river flow can change rapidly in a few hours, so the realization of the descent is always dependent on the analysis and evaluation of the river at the time, also taking into account the experience of the participants and their age group. We may even have to cancel a descent at the beginning of it. In autumn and winter we do not recommend the participation of children and young people up to 16 years old. Participants should pay attention to their glasses. They should come with ribbons/cords so they don't get lost in the river. We do not recommend the use of cell phones, cameras or other electronic devices during the descent. During the descent nothing should be left visible inside the vehicles. And everything that is considered of value should be placed in a backpack (which will always carry the participants or the organization).



#### Other Conditions

- Insurance is included to the final price: a) personal accident insurance includes death's coverage or permanent disability - 20.000€ and treatment costs - 3.500€ (insurance policy 202126631, Allianz Portugal); b) civil liability insurance - includes 75.000€ coverage per incident (insurance policy 203249524, Allianz Portugal)
- Add to the presented prices the current legal IVA Tax.
- Trans Serrano may cancel or change the activity if the weather, fitness of the participants or other conditions put in danger the safety of the group.
- If, without any notification, the group does not appear or, in case of cancellation, 24 hours before the activity, Trans Serrano reserves the right to withhold or demand payment of 50% of the activity price.
